Frequently Asked Questions:

Question: I never received a registration letter or shirt order? Is it too late to sign up?

Answer: No! We tried our best to get every alumni a letter, but we know some were probably missed. On the website there is a link to the registration letter and shirt order form. You can just print them out and get them to us. Of course, we would like them as soon as possible, but we will accept registrations up to a week before. Question: Can we bring children?

Answer: Children are welcome, but we don't have a child's rate on the meal, they will have to pay full rate, if you plan on them eating.

Question: When are we getting our packets or tickets?

Answer: We aren't sending out anything else. There will be a registration table at the beginning of the line where we will check off your names and you will be free to eat at that time.

Question: Do we have to eat at the specified times listed on the registration letter?

Answer: No. These are just suggested times because you may want to eat with members of classes that graduated close to your own year, but by no means are you going to be turned away if you want to eat at a different time!

Question: What is the procedure for the meal, etc?

Answer: The serving times for the meal start at 4:30 with the reunion concluding by 7:00pm. Everyone should try to be in line between 4:30 – 6:00pm if possible. Once you are finished with your meal, we would appreciate it if you could leave the tent area and either tour the school, or visit on the lawn with lawn chairs and other table areas that will be set up. The street dance will start at 9pm.

Question: If I don't plan on eating at the reunion, can I still come to it?

Answer: Any alumni/friends are welcome to come and visit, but since space will be limited, taking up a table where someone is eating, will not be allowed. You may bring lawn chairs, etc. and visit outside of the tents, etc.

Question: Can I have my shirt orders shipped?

Answer: We weren't planning on shipping any shirts because of the shipping costs, etc. In an extreme case, where you have no one to pick yours up even after the reunion, we can make special arrangements, once shipping is paid for.

Question: If we want a unit in the parade, what do we do?

Answer: All you have to do is show up on the "elevator street" by the bowling alley. The parade starts at 10 o'clock with a parade of traveling antique tractors that is coming through town from Forest City, Iowa on their way to Wells, MN. After they are through,

we will have all of the other units. It is pretty much a first come, first choice system. So, show up at least a half hour ahead of time and look for someone from the fire department or Roger Barber, manager of the elevator to help you out.

Question: I have a classic car I want to have in the show Friday night? What do I do?

Answer: The show starts at 5 o'clock and the cars will be line up from the theatre down to the grocery store. Basically, show up a half hour to hour early and the coordinators will get you signed up, etc.
